The UK & Ireland Chapter engages in a wide range of activities and initiatives:

- Three annual competitions:
 - Student Writing & Alternative Media Competition, aimed at engaging students;
 - Research Seed Funding Competition to stimulate collaborative scholarly activity; and
 - Innovative Pedagogy Seed Funding Competition, to integrate the PRME Principles and UN SDGs into the curriculum.
- · Regular seminars, workshops, and training events, including Onboarding Sessions for new PRME Leads and support with PRME SIP reporting.
- An annual conference, next taking place at <u>Queen's</u> Business School, Belfast, from 17-19 June 2025.
